

THE 82nd ANNUAL IOWA MASTERS MEN'S AMATEUR GOLF TOURNAMENT
GEORGE VEENKER MEMORIAL GOLF COURSE - AMES

JULY 12, 13, & 14 2019



The Iowa Masters is a men's amateur invitational Golf Tournament sponsored by Facilities Planning and Management of Iowa State University. It is managed by the Iowa Masters Golf Association (IMGA). The Iowa Masters is one of the Iowa Golf Association's "Major" tournaments that determine the IGA Amateur, Senior Amateur and Super Senior Amateur Player of the Year awards.

The field will be limited to 168 players, 108 in the Open Division and 60 in the Senior Division.

All players will be greeted upon arrival and given tournament instructions and favor.

You will then need to check in at the #10 tee 10 minutes prior to your tee time.

All Players will tee off on #10 on Friday and #1 on Saturday.

GOLF CARTS: While the Committee still encourages walking in the Open and Junior Divisions, we will have approximately 25 carts available for rent in these Divisions. Carts will be assigned on a first-come-first-served basis and depending on demand, tee times for all cart riders will be restricted so that carts may be available for morning and afternoon players. Only players assigned to the cart will be allowed to ride in that cart, with the exception of giving a playing partner a ride back to play a shot in a penalty situation.

PRE-QUALIFIED PLAYERS:

Entries from Pre-Qualified players (see guidelines on the veenker.com website – click on Iowa Masters Logo, then go to Tournament Policies and Procedures) will be given tee time and entry priority if entry is received by Sat. June 23rd and is one of the first 94 entries received. **Players not pre-qualified must have a valid USGA Handicap Index of 8.0 or less.** Entries from these players will be accepted on a first come first served basis following June 23rd. Entries from pre-qualified players received after the 94 player limit, or after the June 16th cut-off date will be accepted in the order received as open spots are available. If the field does not fill by Monday July 8th additional entries will be accepted at the Committee's discretion.

OPEN DIVISION: Based on a full field of 108 players in the Open Division, the field will be cut to the low 64 players plus ties for the final round. The low 48 players plus ties will compete in the Masters Flight. The remaining players will compete in the Cyclone Flight unless they opt to declare for the Masters Flight prior to the time when final round pairings are made. 26 places will be paid in the Masters Flight and 5 places in the Cyclone Flight unless the Cyclone Flight ends up with fewer than 16 players. If this occurs, payouts in this flight may be adjusted accordingly.

JUNIOR DIVISION: Players 18 years of age or younger as of July 12, 2019 will play in both the Open and Junior Divisions. Junior Division results will be based on the full 54 holes of play. First place in the Junior Division will be awarded a trophy.

SENIOR DIVISION: Pre-Qualified Senior entries will be given entry and tee time priority until the cut-off date of Sat. June 23rd or until 52 pre-qualified spots are filled before the cut-off date. Other Senior entries, with a valid USGA Handicap Index of 8.0 or less will be accepted on a first come first served basis. Based on a field of 60 Senior Players, the field will be cut to the low 28 plus ties for the final round. 15 places will be paid.

SUPER SENIOR DIVISION: (New in 2017) - In support of the IGA Super Senior (65 and Over) Player of the Year Award, we have added a Super Senior event to be played over the first 36 holes within the Senior Division. A first place trophy will be awarded plus Super Senior points. These players will also compete in the overall Senior Division for prizes.

CART RULES

No transportation of ANYONE who is not a Masters Player will be permitted from tee-off until completion of play.

PENALTY FOR VIOLATION MAY BE DISQUALIFICATION OF PLAYER.

When entering, if you intend to ride, the playing partner you request to be paired with the first two days must also be riding. To reserve a cart, payment of \$35.00 for your half of the cart for the first 2 days must be submitted with your entry fee.

THE IGA DRESS CODE WILL BE ENFORCED

As a part of the Iowa State University campus, and under Iowa Law, all of the buildings and grounds associated with Veenker Memorial Golf Course are smoke free areas.

Please plan accordingly.

ENTRY CONFIRMATION: If you wish to confirm your Masters entry, you may either send a self addressed stamped envelope along with your entry, or check the website, www.veenker.com (via Masters Logo)
The Committee will try to enter names of entrants onto this website daily so that you may check the status of your entry.

CANCELLATION POLICY: Entries cancelled on or before June 23rd will be refunded in full. Cancellations between June 24th and July 10th will be refunded in the amount of \$95.00. Cancellations on July 11th and after will not be refunded unless the opening is filled with another player in which case a refund of \$85.00 will be issued. Cart fees collected will be refunded in full.

PACE OF PLAY

Since reducing the number of players to 168 in 2011 and playing in threesomes for walkers, the pace of play has improved. We realize that tournament play is susceptible to slow play, but there is no reason to expect play to exceed 4 ½ hours. We have ball spotters on the course at strategic locations to assist golfers but we also need cooperation from the golfers to improve pace of play.

We will again be putting an emphasis on pace of play with some special rules outlined under “Pace of Play” on the Masters section of the Veenker website. We suggest that you read these rules and procedures prior to the tournament.

PRACTICE ROUNDS

Please call the Veenker clubhouse at 515-294-6727 to reserve a tee time for practice rounds if desired. Practice round fees are not included in your Iowa Masters entry fee. No tee times will be available after 2:00 p.m. on Thursday July 11th to allow for course tournament preparations.

ENTRY FEE FOR THE 2019 IOWA MASTERS WILL BE \$130.00.

Your Entry Fee includes green fees, pre round range fees, prizes and \$1 for the Herman Sani Scholarship Fund, \$1 for the Derek Harmon Scholarship Fund.

Cart Fees will be additional as indicated on the Entry Form.

TEE TIMES:

Tee times should be available on the www.veenkergolf.com (via Masters Logo) on or after July 10th. Click on “Iowa Masters” Logo, select “Tee Times”, select “1st” round or “2nd” round, select your name. This will bring up your tee time, and scoring history if you have played in prior Iowa Masters tournaments. Tee times will not be mailed to golfers. You may also phone 515-294-6727 to inquire about your tee times.

All golfers will tee off on the #10 tee on Friday. All golfers will tee off on the #1 tee on Saturday.
